Introduction

Didcot Cricket Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members.

Didcot Cricket Club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents/carers or guardians associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with insert name of person and position within cricket club.

Code of Conduct

Junior members of Didcot Cricket Club are expected to and agree to abide to the Code of Conduct as listed below:

1. I will play for the fun, and not just because my parents want me to.
2. I will always play by both the laws and spirit of the game.
3. I will always accept *and respect officials and Umpires and their decisions* without question and never show dissent.
4. I will always control my temper and will not cheat.
5. I will remember that cricket is a team game.
6. I will always respect other players, coaches and parents both on my side and the opposition. *I will respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.*
7. I will always be well behaved, both in attitude and language. (Swearing will not be tolerated).
8. I will always treat the Coaches with respect and carry out their instruction to the best of my ability at all times.
9. I will respect all equipment that belongs to Didcot Cricket Club. When using this equipment I will use it as intended and not damage it in any way. I will always ask before borrowing other player's personal equipment.
10. Remember that you depend heavily on your parents help and support and behave accordingly. Be helpful at home and make sure that you keep up to date with all your other commitments, such as homework!
11. *I will keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform my coach or Captain I am going to be late.*
12. *I will wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.*
13. *I will pay any fees for training or events promptly.*
14. *I will not smoke, consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.*

Coaching MAY involve Didcot Cricket Club's young cricketers being video recorded whilst performing certain skills to help identify how to improve specific techniques.
